HEALTH + SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

The health and safety of Eat Great Winter attendees and staff are a top priority. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, additional procedures will be implemented at the 2022 Eat Great Winter event to ensure measures are being taken to keep attendees and staff as safe as possible. All event plans have been communicated with local and state health officials and are in compliance with CDC guidelines. Please note, health + safety precautions are subject to change, and attendees will be notified of any changes.

Before You Arrive On-Site

Upon Arrival

- Sanitizing products will be available for all attendees at check-in, the main tent, igloos and restrooms.
- All groups are asked to maintain a six-foot distance between other parties.
- Guests are required to wear their facial coverings except when eating or drinking. Staff will be wearing their masks.

Sanitation of Igloos

- Our staff will use a broad-spectrum disinfectant to thoroughly clean tables in between each reservation and at the end of each night of Eat Great Winter.
